## Dellums Building (Oakland) Install Interior Lighting Project

**Customer: GSA Oakland** 

Value: \$6.2M

Scope: MCB Lighting & Electrical, under contract with Phillips, conducted energy surveys (audits) and analysis, energy conservation proposals and provided in-house installation and commissioning of a highly complex lighting system (computer controlled). MCB Lighting & Electrical replaced 16K fixtures in over 40 federal agencies located in the Ronald V. Dellums Federal Building in Oakland California. MCB installed a complex DALI lighting system which at the time was the first in the government.

This system is a programmable, addressable lighting system that facilitates the control of each lighting fixture individually from 100% down to 10%.

### Burton Building (San Francisco) Install State of the Art Lighting

**Customer: GSA San Francisco** 

Value: \$6M

Scope: MCB Lighting & Electrical replaced 12K fixtures in over 40 federal agencies located in the Phillip Burton Federal Building in San Francisco California. MCB installed a complex DALI lighting system which at the time was the first in the government, at least at GSA. During the GSA pilot for work station lighting MCB installed over 25K fixtures in occupied space, at multiple locations.

#### **VA Lighting Upgrade**

**Customer: Veterans Affairs Agency** 

Value: \$6M

**Scope:** MCB Lighting & Electrical sourced interior retrofit kits resulting in support of Veterans Affairs Agency.

#### **National Park Service Lighting Upgrade**

(High-profile Washington, DC contract)

**Customer: National Park Service** 

Value: \$1.6M

**Scope:** MCB Lighting & Electrical sourced and delivered 4,500 specialty interior and exterior lighting in support of National Park Service. We exceeded customer expectations with flexible response on new and emerging requirements during project installation.

#### **Corpus Christi Army Depot**

Customer: US Army Value: \$4.2M

Scope: MCB Lighting & Electrical replaced and/or retrofitted 15,000 fixtures, resulting in estimated energy cost savings of \$900k/year. This project involved turnkey lighting project development, audit, supply, and installation. We installed over 1200 highbay fixtures and 10,000 LED retrofit kits. We overcame significant challenges: the project required remote storage from installation site, involved 20 full truckloads of lighting products. The work was in a high ops tempo operations facility that required close coordination and cooperation. We exceeded the customers expectations by being flexible, working around customers installation schedule and adjusting our retrofit areas, as needed to meet the customers needs.

#### **Schofield Barracks Lighting Upgrade**

Customer: US Army Value: \$590K

**Scope:** MCB Lighting & Electrical sourced and delivered all lighting control equipment for this project. Exceeded expectations

by rapidly coordinating order and expedited delivery.

#### **Wingate Apartment Outdoor Lighting Upgrade**

**Customer: GYLNN GROUP** 

Value: \$230K

**Scope:** MCB Lighting & Electrical replaced parking light fixtures and 400watt exterior security lighting for three-story multifloor apartment buildings. Lights were on top of the apartment buildings, so safety for residents and electricians was paramount.

#### **Andrews AFB AF Exterior LED Demo Project**

**Customer: USAF Andrews AFB Golf Course** 

Value: \$70K

Scope: MCB Lighting & Electrical replaced street lights and parking light fixtures with LED fixtures as part of an Air Force LED Pilot/<u>Demo</u> Project. MCB installed over 40 roadway and parking lot lights for the President's golf course. Measurements, pictures and video, were recorded, totaling over 130 recorded measurements; showed significantly increased light levels with a 70% reduction in energy cost.

# **Energy Management, Controllability, M&V**

- Full spectrum control and manageable consumption/dimming control to 10%
- Lighting and consumption levels set to 70% the first 24 months
- Load shedding and curtailment during peak demand
- Scheduling of work cycles with system overrides for individual or group fixtures
- Enterprise Architecture for remote management and monitoring (US Air Force desire)
- Continuous M&V capability, either option 1 or option 2, critical for compliance with ESPC authorization and appropriations laws
